➤ **Nature and extent of involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs/ improvements**

The College has the required Staff as per AICTE/RTM Nagapur University norms who are actively participate in various academic activities of the Institution. Our top most priority is to conduct classes punctually. If any faculty member is on leave their classes are adjusted to other faculty members of the department, thereby there is no cancellation of the class. The attendance of the students is monitored periodically by the nominated authorities and parents are formed in addition to counseling of the student in this regard.

On the basis of the performance in class tests, sessional examinations and University exams, each department will identify average and backward students in each discipline and special classes are conducted for academic improvement of the student.

We are planning to arrange campus placements and in this direction we have chalked out plans to equip students to face Campus and non-campus interviews effectively.

College recruited a Lecturer who is good in conducting a training classes in the fields of aptitude classes, personality development, spoken English and communication sessions. These special programmes improve soft skills, performance in aptitude test, group discussions and ability to face interviews etc.

➤ **Mechanism/Norms & Procedure for democratic/good governance**

AICTE specified rules, regulations and procedures are followed for good governance. Other guidelines are taken from the Affiliation University and state government resolutions. The following procedures are adopted to provide good governance.

(1). The student information data base is maintained in the Principal's Office and it provide the complete details whenever required. (2). The attendance of the students is made transparent to the students and their parents from time to time. (3). Internal assessment of students through surprise tests/unit tests/internal tests (4). Weak students are provided guidance and counseling (5). College Buses are operating from Nagpur, on payment, so that they can Spend minimum time in traveling and attend classes punctually. (6).Free transport facility is provided to faculty by the college so that faculty can interact with the students while traveling. (7). College is situated in M.I.D.C area and hence planning has been done to provide industrial training and organize industrial tours, for the students. (8).Anti Ragging measures are strictly implemented to prevent Ragging of junior students. (9). Canteen facilities and other amenities are provided to the students.

➤ **Student Feedback on institutional governance/Faculty performance**

Feedback from Students are taken from time to time so that any rectification in institutional governance, faculty performance, departmental activity and self development if needed are implemented..

➤ **Grievances redressal mechanism for faculty, staff and students**

The teaching faculty, supporting staff and students express their problems to the respective Head of the Departments. In case the problem is not resolved at the department level, the matter is referred to the attention of Principal/Vice-Principal. Generally the problems of less magnitude and which are routine in nature are settled at Principal's level. If the aggrieved party is not satisfied he/she is at liberty to approach the Secretary of the Institution. If the nature of the problem is of higher magnitude, then it will be brought to the notice of the Chairman.

A Committee is constituted with three members to attend to the grievances of teaching faculty, supporting staff and students. Principal acts as the convener of the grievance redressal committee. A grievance box is fixed on the wall in the main building with proper lock and guard. Vice-Principal opens the box once in a week and collects these letters and place before the Committee for necessary action.

However in the first year so far only 178 students are joined from CAP round-1, CAP round-2 and management Quota. These students are made into three sections of 60 each in two sections and another section with 58 students. When the remaining students of 92 joined in the subsequent rounds they will be made two sections. As the two sections are not running teaching faculty have less load than the expected load. After the final CAP round Teaching load of each and every faculty will be uploaded in this place.
